



Risk Assessment Safety Measures

Following the new guidelines, published by the government on 9th July, we are organising a series of open-air performances in our walled garden.

Measures we are taking to **reduce risks** of infection:

Performers and audience members

- staff and patrons entering the site are asked to ensure they are in good health and are exhibiting no symptoms of Covid-19
- there is controlled access to the venue: a single gate permits access, allowing us to control audience and staff numbers precisely
- although the fire officer indicated groups of 75+ could occupy the space, audiences will be limited to an absolute maximum of 50
- attendance is exclusively bookable in advance to allow “booking bubbles”: the seating will be configured prior to each show to allow social distancing between each group
- all audience members are required to maintain social distance from other patrons and performers
- other public areas remain closed
- refreshments may be ordered in advance of attendance
- anti-bacterial handwash is available at the site entrance and all patrons and staff are requested to use it
- toilets are for emergency use only and are disinfected regularly

Performers

- **participants entering the site are asked to ensure they are in good health and are exhibiting no symptoms of Covid-19**
- **all artists are asked to refer to the government guidance to ensure that they observe the regulations relating to their performance**
- **there is an open-air backstage area, and a dry store of props, costumes and musical instruments**
- **all interior doors (such as to the store room) are wedged open to remove use of door handles**
- **artists may wear face masks if they wish**
- **the stage area will be sprayed with disinfectant after each performance, prior to the next day's rehearsals and shows**
- **all performance and backstage spaces will have their own supply of hand sanitizer**
- **artists are also asked to bring their own hand sanitizer**
- **artists may not leave any equipment on site after their performance**
